Information for Kuo Shu Lei Tai Fighters – 2020

All fighters are required to make weight for the weight class in which they registered.

There will be a mandatory Lei Tai rules meeting on Friday, July 24 at 8:45 pm in the Hunt Valley (main) Ballroom. **ALL LEI TAI FIGHTERS AND COACHES MUST ATTEND THIS MEETING.** This meeting will cover rules as well as procedures for before, during, and after the fights. If you are fighting in an elimination match, you must be at the Lei Tai prep area (Salon B) no later than 1:00 pm on Saturday afternoon. The fight order will be posted on the morning of Saturday, July 25. Each team coach or a representative of the competitor will have an opportunity to review the fight order on Saturday morning, prior to the issuance of the final fight order. Please listen to the announcements in the main ballroom on Saturday morning for information on the time the fight order will be available for review in Salon B. During the Lei Tai fighting matches, you will have **60 seconds** to respond if your name is called. **If you are not present, you will automatically forfeit the fight.**

You must wear the regulation uniform and gear. Jewelry of any type (necklaces, earrings, rings, etc.) must be taken off prior to your fight. **Failure to comply with these rules may result in disqualification.**

Only two coaches are allowed in each fighter's corner. **Coaching from the corner or sidelines during the match is strictly prohibited.**

Tentative schedule for the fights:

Saturday afternoon, July 25: 2:00-5:00 pm – Elimination matches

Saturday evening, July 25: 7:30-11:00 pm – Elimination and final matches
