(For the 2013-2014 academic year, the Helen Gee Chin Scholarship Foundation will make awards of \$2500 to two or more students)

Eligibility Criteria

Scholarship Applicants must:

- Be a U.S. citizen
- Plan to enroll full-time as an undergraduate at an accredited U.S. four-year college or university for the entire 2013-2014 academic year
- Have studied one or more of the Chinese Martial Arts – Kung Fu, Wu Shu, or Tai Chi – for at least 5 years
- Have a “B” average grade or better

Award Criteria

Selection is based on the following:

- Martial arts achievement (tournament medals*, contribution to martial arts)
- Academic achievement
- An essay explaining what the study of martial arts has meant to the applicant
- Participation and leadership in community and school activities, work experience, educational and career goals, and unusual circumstances
